Instructions for installation
 Refer to DPLC Landscape Specifications and Management for full instructions for installation. The following summary applies:

Topsoil
 Onsite topsoil resources are limited, and may contain perennial weeds and debris. All planting areas are to be excavated to a depth of 300mm for shrubs and 450mm for trees and filled with consolidated imported multipurpose topsoil conforming to British Standard BS3882:2007.

Planting
 All planting is to be installed in accordance with British Standard BS8545:2014. Trees from nursery to independence in the landscape. Recommendations. Trees are to be planted as bare root or root-balled stock between November and March, avoiding root exposure to freezing conditions.

Management
 All planting is to be watered in accordance with the schedule for watering set out in the Landscape Specifications and Management. In first five years after planting any dead or dying plants are to be replaced. Tree stakes, shrub shelters and spiral guards are to be removed five years after planting. Tree ties must be checked seasonally and loosened to prevent constriction.
